In 1958 the teleplay *Days of Wine and Roses* was broadcast in the US. Directed by John Frankenheimer and starring Cliff Robertson and Piper Laurie, it caused such an impact among the public that it was soon made into a film. In 1962, it was premiered on the big screen, directed by Blake Edwards with a screenplay by Miller himself and starring Jack Lemmon and Lee Remick. *Days of Wine and Roses* earned, among other recognitions, 5 nominations and 2 Oscar awards, 3 Bafta Awards, 4 Golden Globes, 3 Laurel Awards... Almost 50 years have gone by and still this exceptional text rings true and remains significant.
