Diego Suárez (piano) and Ricky Vivar (guitar) share the stage for the first time with singer Raquel Pelayo. Suárez and Vivar are internationally renowned musicians, heirs and transmitters of Fats Waller and James P. Johnson's glorious tradition of the stride, of Art Tatum's cascades of notes, and of the distinctive language of Django Reinhardt and Eddie Lang's guitars. On this occasion they will be joined by Raquel Pelayo, a jazz singer from Malaga with an eminent professional career, with whom they will perform a varied and lively jazz repertoire, full of lyricism and strength.

The trio is completed by Pablo Guzmán on guitar and Joan Masana on double bass, musicians with a long national and international career in the world of jazz.

14 years have passed since the release of 'Kase. O Jazz Magnetism', with more than 150 concerts, international tours in Mexico, Argentina, Chile, Colombia and Uruguay and an album that has become a benchmark for the genre (and with which an entire generation of musicians, MC's and producers has grown up). Now, Escandaloso Expósito (MC, saxophone), Dani Comas (guitar), Juan Pablo Balcazar (bass), Dani Comas (guitar), Juan Berbin (percussion) and Dani Domínguez (drums) are embarking on a tour with their unique blend of hip hop, jazz and other music, yet maintaining the spirit that brought them together.

Based on standards written by some of the greatest jazz musicians, such as Ellington, Gershwin, Porter, Strayhorn, Monk and Rodgers and Hammerstein, the trio formed by Lluc Casares, Dee Jay Foster and Guillem Arnedo will offer a repertoire of songs that reflect their experiences and moods. To the rhythm of jazz, the essential aspects of the music are masterfully underpinned by a trio that combines the impressive melodic capacity of Lluc Casares and the solid, integrated rhythmic base formed by Foster and Arnedo.

Antti Sarpila is possibly the most famous clarinet player in the world today representing the style of the great Benny Goodman.

He has recorded more than 30 albums of his own and around 100 as a sideman throughout his musical life. He has recorded and collaborated with musicians such as Buddy DeFranco, Wynton Marsalis, Thad Jones, Buddy Haggard, Scott Hamilton and Count Basie.

In 1996 he was awarded the Louis Armstrong Award and in 1997 the Yrjö Society Prize by the Finnish Jazz Union.

Antti has been touring Europe, the USA, the Middle East, Australia and Russia continuously for more than 20 years.

He formed the Hot Club de Andalucía, together with pianist Diego Suárez and guitarist Ricky Vivar, as a tribute to the genuine, entertaining and special sound of the famous Quintette du Hot Club de France, of which the famous Django Reinhardt and violinist Stephan Grapelli were members. A style and a way of playing that marked an era and a trend in European jazz-swing in the 1930s.

Anachronic is a swing band that evokes the essence of classic jazz with a contemporary touch. Ana Villalba's smooth, deep voice leads the band and mesmerises listeners while Stefano Tomaselli's saxophone fills the air with intricate and at the same time nostalgic melodies. Fali Martínez's guitar brings a vibrant and warm rhythm, while Juan Baca's double bass provides a solid and enveloping foundation. Together they create an elegant and sophisticated atmosphere, where each note resonates like a whisper of times gone by, inviting you to enjoy the magic of swing.
