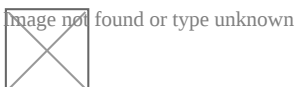

Ariel Brínguez is a saxophonist, composer and arranger who graduated from the University of the Arts of Havana. He has played with Simply Red, Javier Colina, Niña Pastori, Paquito D'Rivera and Ketama, amongst many others. He has two American Grammy awards for his collaboration with Chucho Valdés in the album *Tribute to Irakere: Live in Marciac* and with Alejandro Sanz for the album *El tren de los momentos*, as well as a Latin Grammy for *Voyager* by Iván 'Melón' Lewis. He has published three works, namely *Raíces en colores*, with which he won the 2009 Opera Prima award; *Experience*, and *Nostalgia cubana*, with which he is currently on





tour.
