Pluto?n is Ernesto Aurignac's new musical universe. Inspired by the sounds of the cosmos, in this album Aurignac blends his own music with impressionist and expressionist jazz influences which he endows with a unique instrumentation. The result is so magic and moving, he says, that it takes the audience on an interstellar acoustic voyage.

Following the success of his three albums as leader – *UNO* (2014), *Anunnakis* (2015) and *Ernesto Aurignac Trío "Plays standards" vol. 1* (2016)–, and after receiving the 2016 Enderrock Award for Best Jazz Album for *MAP Mezquida-Aurignac-Prats*, the saxophone player from Malaga will present his new record: a unique proposal and his last bit of madness for alto saxophone and nonet.

The project was the result of a commission by the Madrid International Festival of Sacred Art. It was premiered in a memorable concert at the Teatros del Canal and to great acclaim from audience and critics alike.
